Effective LifeGroup co-leaders realize that they are the support that can keep the leader from burning out. Listed below are some expectations that will guide you <u>as you commit to co-lead your LifeGroup this year.</u>

- 1. **Emergency Back-up** Even great leaders are human. Things happen to prevent the best-laid plans. As co-leader you are ready and willing to step in and facilitate the meeting should your leader have to be absent.
- Apprentice The growth model of a LifeGroup Ministry is exponential.
 You are learning under your leader so that one day you will take on your own LifeGroup and others will have a chance to connect in your group and have a place to belong.
- 3. Partner You will prepare for group meetings with your leader.
- 4. Progress Tracker Help take attendance for your group. Attendance is more than a number. Attendance shows us how active we are as a LifeGroup Ministry. It also indicates when there are people we need to check on. Sometimes "absences" equate to "needs."
- Co-communicator You will help your leader with communication, sharing that responsibility.
